STORK Project Results: Paneuropean eID Interoperability Demonstrated

Abstract:

Secure idenTity acrOss boRders linKed (STORK) is a project co-funded by the European Commission as a part of its Competitiveness and Innovation Programme (CIP) in order to address, in a cross-border scenario, the identity management problem. This project, developed during the last three years, has brought together, in its two phases, 17 countries and 38 consortium partners mixing public and private sector organizations. By running six real-life pilots the achievement of interoperability of national electronic identities among European member states involved has been proven. One of these pilots, the Students mobility one, has focused on the use os University services by foreign students. This article will summarize the main outcomes of the project and will focus on its sustainability and further adoption by new stakeholders.
